Hanukkah lights, Hanukkah nights by Kimmelman, Leslie / Himmelman, John, illus. 1992

An extended family celebrates the eight nights of Hanukkah. Includes music for "I have a little Dreidel" with button to play song.

Chanukah is... by Lemelman, Martin 1988

Board book shows the history and celebration of Hanukkah in very simple words.

My first Hanukkah board book (My first word books) by Lister, Clare, ed.

Board book that presents the origins of Hanukkah and how it is uniquely celebrated with foods, games, and songs. Labeled illustrations and related activities introduce vocabulary words, numbers, color.

Disney's Winnie The Pooh and The Hanukkah Dreidel by Milne, A. A. / Moore, Sparky, ill. 1998

In this illustrated version of "The Dreidel Song," Winnie the Pooh and his friends make and play with a clay dreidel.

Board book in which a family celebrates Hanukkah by lighting the Menorah, eating chocolate gelt and latkes, and opening gifts.

Board book describing symbols of Hanukah in simple language.

Hanukah Pop-up by Scharfstein, Sol / Friedman, Aaron, illus. 1983

Pop-up book colorfully illustrates history and celebration of Hanukkah.

Rainbow candles: a Chanukah counting book by Shostak, Myra. / Springer, Sally, illus. 1986

Simple board book that counts Hanukkah candles.

Hanukkah Sing-Along 5 (CD) by Children's Village of Jerusalem Choir / Levitan, Ralph, arr. 2005

Hanukkah songs performed by the children's choir from the Children's Village in Jerusalem.

AGE 4-7

Chanukah in Chelm by Adler, David A. 1997

When the rabbi tells Mendel to get a table to hold the menorah, Mendel, like a true Chelmiter, makes the task more difficult than it should be.

Hanukkah cookies with sprinkles by Adler, David A. / Ebbeler, Jeffrey, illus. 2015

Sara learns about the Jewish tradition of tzedakah when she shares food with a hungry stranger during Chanukah.

A picture book of Hanukkah by Adler, David A. / Heller, Linda, ill. 1982

Discusses how the celebration of Hanukkah came about, what it signifies, and the ways in which it is celebrated today.

- Maccabee! The story of Hanukkah by Balsley, Tilda / Harrington, David, illus. 2010
Judah and the small army of Maccabees fight to free Jerusalem from the cruel armies of King Antiochus in this rollicking, rhyming version of the famous Hanukkah story.
- Hanukkah fun: Great things to make and do by Bastyra, Judy / Ward, Catherine. 1996
A brief history of Hanukkah accompanies recipes, craft projects, and other activities to help celebrate this holiday.
- I have a little dreidel by Baum, Maxie / Paschkis, Julie, ill. 2006
An illustrated retelling of the classic Hanukkah song, with directions for playing the dreidel game and a recipe for making latkes.
- The bagel baker of Mulliner Lane by Blau, Judith Hope 1976
The bagel baker finally finds a use for the many stale bagels that he can't bear to throw away.
- The Gift by Brodmann, Aliana. / Carnabuci, Anthony, illus. 1993
In post-World War II Germany, a young girl visits various shops before deciding how to spend her Hanukkah money.
- One Candle by Bunting, Eve / Popp, Wendy, illus. 2002
Every year a family celebrates Hanukkah by retelling the story of how Grandma and her sister managed to mark the day while in a concentration camp.
- Hanukkah cat by Burstein, Chaya M. 1985
A stray orange kitten joins Lenny's family on the first night of Hanukkah.
- The KvetchiT -- a Hanukkah tale by Butchins, Larry. / Yitzchak, Celia, illus. 1994
Story about Kvetchers (complainers) and how they affect others.
- Rodney "the latke kid" by Chait, Irma / Rosser, Toby, illus. 1980
Simple story in rhyme about boy named Rodney who eats so many latkes he floats away.
- Engineer Ari And the Hanukkah Mishap by Cohen, Deborah Bodin / Kober, Shahar, illus. 2011
Israel's first train chugs from Jaffa to Jerusalem allowing Engineer Ari to see the place where the miracle of Hanukkah began.
- The Christmas menorahs: how a town fought hate by Cohn, Janice / Farnsworth, Bill, illus. 1995
Describes how in 1993, the citizens of Billings, Montana joined together to fight a series of hate crimes during Chanukah.
- Northern lights -- a Hanukkah story by Conway, Diana Cohen / Haas, Shelly O., illus. 1994
When a storm grounds their plane, a Jewish family celebrates Hanukkah with an Eskimo family.
- Papa's latkes by Edwards, Michelle / Schuett, Stacey, illus. 2004
On the first Hanukkah after Mama died, Papa and his two daughters try to make latkes and celebrate without her.
- Queen of The Hanukkah Dosas by Ehrenberg, Pamela / Sarkar, Anjan, illus. 2017
A boy is worried that his little sister's climbing will spoil the first night of Hanukkah, when his family combines his father's Jewish traditions with his mother's East Indian cooking.
- Latke, The Lucky Dog by Fischer, Ellen / Beeke, Tiphonie, illus. 2014
A family rescues a dog from a shelter during Hanukkah, and the pup proceeds to create holiday hijinks as he gets used to his new home.
- The Hanukah play by Garvey, Robert / Josephson, Gabe, illus. 1979
Rachel and David want to play the main roles in the school Hanukkah play.

- Jeremy's dreidel by Gellman, Ellie / Friedman, Judith, illus. 1992
Jeremy creates a clay dreidel with braille dots for his dad, who is blind; includes Hanukkah crafts directions.
- The borrowed Hanukkah latkes by Glaser, Linda / Cote, Nancy, illus. 1997
A young girl finds a way to include her elderly neighbor in her family's Hanukkah celebration.
- Mrs. Greenberg's Messy Hanukkah by Glaser, Linda / Cote, Nancy, ill. 2004
When Rachel makes latkes with her friend Mrs. Greenberg, the project turns out to be a very messy one.
- Just enough is plenty: a Hanukkah tale by Goldin, Barbara Diamond / Chwast, Seymour, illus. 1988
A poor Polish family shares whatever they have with a mysterious traveling peddler on Hanukkah.
- Gracie's Night: A Hanukkah Story by Gordon, Lynn Taylor / Brown, Laura, illus. 2013
There's lots of love in Gracie's and Papa's lives, but not much money. Gracie finds a resourceful way to buy Papa some well-deserved Hanukkah gifts, but an encounter on a bitterly cold night opens her eyes and alters her plans. (Gracie's Night is based on the true Gordon family tradition of foregoing gifts on one Hanukkah night and giving anonymously to someone in need.)
- The Hanukah tooth by Greene, Jacqueline Dembar / Quellet, Pauline Allin, illus. 1981
Nathan, who is about to lose his first tooth, learns about the meaning of Hanukkah.
- All about Hanukkah by Groner, Judyth Saypol / Wikler, Madeline / Schanzer, Rosalyn, illus. 1988
Children's book on Hanukkah includes historical background, observance, music, and games.
- Treasures of Chanukah by Hildebrandt, Greg / Hildebrandt, Greg, illus. / Scrocco, Jean, ed. 1987
Presents a collection of songs, stories, poems, and prayers in celebration of Hanukkah.
- The Hanukkah story by Hirsh, Marilyn / Hirsh, Marilyn, illus. 1977
Relates the struggle of Judah Maccabee and his small army against the overwhelming might of the Syrians and how this event gave rise to the celebration of Hanukkah.
- I love Hanukkah by Hirsh, Marilyn / Hirsh, Marilyn, illus. 1984
A young boy describes his family's celebration of Hanukkah and all the things he likes about the holiday.
- Potato pancakes all around: a Hanukkah tale by Hirsh, Marilyn / Hirsh, Marilyn, illus. 1978
A wandering peddler teaches the villagers how to make potato pancakes from a crust of bread.
- Emanuel and the Hanukkah Rescue by Hyde, Heidi Smith / Akib, Jamel, ill. 2012
In 19th century New England, nine-year-old Emanuel's father refuses to place their Hanukkah menorah in their window, fearful of revealing the family's Jewish background. Craving freedom from fear, Emanuel stows away aboard a whaling ship; when the ship becomes lost in a storm, only the Hanukkah lights showing in a window light the way home.
- In the month of Kislev: a story for Hanukkah by Jaffe, Nina. / August, Louise, illus. 1992
A rich, arrogant merchant takes the family of a poor peddler to court and learns a lesson about the meaning of Hanukkah. Includes bibliographical references (p. [32]).
- All-Of-A-Kind Family Hanukkah by Jenkins, Emily / Taylor, Sydney / Zelinsky, Paul O., illus. 2018
In 1912 New York, Gertie feels left out while Mama and her four older sisters cook Hanukkah dinner, but Papa comes home and asks her help with an important task. Based on the All-of-a-Kind Family books by Sydney Taylor.
- The Ziz and the Hanukkah miracle by Jules, Jacqueline / Kahn, Katherine, ill. 2006
The Ziz, a huge and magic bird from midrashic legend, helps the Maccabees find enough oil to light the menorah and restore the temple, leading to the miracle that is celebrated every year at Hanukkah.
- A Family Hanukkah by Katz, Bobbi / Herzfeld, Caryl, illus. 1992
Rachel and Jonathan join their family at their grandparents' house for a traditional celebration of Hanukkah.

- When Mindy Saved Hanukkah by Kimmel, Eric A. / McClintock, Barbara, illus. 1998
Hanukkah story, reminiscent of The Borrowers, in which a tiny Jewish family lives behind the walls of the Eldridge Street Synagogue and must contend with a cat.
- Asher and the capmakers: a Hanukkah story by Kimmel, Eric A. / Hillenbrand, Will, illus. 1992
On his way to get an egg for his mother to use for latkes, a young boy encounters mischievous fairies who take him on an adventure to Jerusalem.
- The magic dreidels: a Hanukkah story by Kimmel, Eric A. / Krenina, Katya, illus. 1996
With help from his goblin friend, a little boy turns the tables on his sneaky neighbor and retrieves the magic dreidels just in time to celebrate Hanukkah.
- The Chanukkah guest by Kimmel, Eric A./ Carmi, Giora, illus. 1990
On the first night of Hanukkah, Old Bear wanders into Bubbe Brayna's house and eats the latkes intended for the rabbi. (Sydney Taylor Award: 1990)
- Hershel and the Hanukkah goblins by Kimmel, Eric A. / Hyman, Trina Schart, illus. 1989
Hershel outwits the goblins that haunt the old synagogue and prevent the villagers from celebrating Hanukkah.
- The Golem's Latkes by Kimmel, Eric A. / Jasinski, Aaron, illus. 2011
Rabbi Judah Loew ben Bezalel visits the Emperor, leaving a new housemaid to prepare for his Hanukkah party, but returns to find that she has misused the clay man he created. Includes historical and cultural notes.
- Zigazak!: a magical Hanukkah night by Kimmel, Eric A. / Goodell, Jon, illus. 2001
Two devils attempt to spoil Hanukkah in the town of Brisk until the Rabbi outsmarts them.
- Hanukkah, the festival of lights by Koralek, Jenny / Wijngaard, Juan, illus. 1990
Retells the history of Hanukkah.
- Sadie's Almost Marvelous Menorah by Korngold, Jamie / Fortenberry, Julie, illus. 2013
Sadie breaks her handmade Chanukah menorah, but learns that, even broken, it can still have a role to play in the holiday celebration.
- Little Red Ruthie: A Hanukkah Tale by Koster, Gloria / Eastland, Sue, illustrator. 2017
Heading through the forest to her Bubbe Basha's house to make latkes (potato pancakes) on the first night of Hanukkah, Little Red Ruthie encounters a hungry wolf. Includes a recipe for latkes.
- Hanukkah at Valley Forge by Krensky, Stephen / Harlin, Greg, illus. 2006
During the Revolutionary War, a Jewish soldier from Poland lights the menorah on the first night of Hanukkah and tells General George Washington the story of the holiday.
- A great miracle happened there: a Chanukah story by Kuskin, Karla. / Parker, Robert Andrew, ill. 1993
On the first night of Hanukkah, a mother tells her family and a young guest the story of the holiday's origin.
- Nathan Blows Out the Hanukkah Candles by Lehman-Wilzig, Tami / Katzman, Nicole / Tugeau, Jeremy, illus. 2011
Although Jacob finds his autistic brother, Nathan, annoying, he gets angry when a new neighbor calls Nathan weird. But their mothers help the boys get along with a special Hanukkah observance.
- This is the Dreidel by Levine, Abby / Billin-Frye, Paige, ill. 2003
Max and his sister enjoy the dreidel and other special parts of their family's holiday celebration.
- Jodie's Hanukkah dig by Levine, Anna / Topaz, Ksenia, illus. 2008
Jodie dreams of one day becoming a famous archaeologist and when her father takes her to visit a dig in Modiin, Israel, home of the Maccabees, she is uniquely able to help.

- All the lights in the night by Levine, Arthur A. / Ransome, James E., illus. 1991
Moses and his little brother Benjamin find a way to celebrate Hanukkah during their dangerous emigration from Russia to Palestine.
- Latkes and applesauce -- a Hanukkah story by Manushkin, Fran / Spowart, Robin, illus. 1990
A blizzard leaves a family housebound for Hanukkah and they share the little food they have with some starving animals who later return the favor.
- The Modi'in Motel -- an idol tale for Chanukah by Miller, Deborah Uchill / Ostrove, Karen, illus. 1986
Nonsense in rhyme of how the women and children were the real heroes of the Maccabee revolt.
- The Ugly menorah by Moss, Marissa / Moss, Marissa, illus. 1996
A little girl who misses her grandfather at Hanukkah hears the story of the clumsy menorah he made for her grandmother long ago.
- The only one club by Naliboff, Jane / Hopkins, Jeff, illus. 2004
When Jennifer is singled out in her class as the only one to make Chanukah decorations during the Christmas season, she decides to create the "The Only One Club", but she and everyone else come to realize that they are all different in unique ways.
- Harvest of light by Ofanansky, Allison. / Alpern, Eliyahu, photo. 2008
An Israeli family raises olives and uses some of the oil to light their Hanukkah menorah. Real photos of olive harvesting and production.
- The Miracle Jar: A Hanukkah Story by Penn, Audrey / Lyon, Lea, illus. 2008
A family in the Old Country hopes to recreate the miracle of the first Hanukkah by making a small jar of cooking oil last long enough to make a treat for each of the eight nights.
- The Trees of the dancing goats by Polacco, Patricia, 1944- / Polacco, Patricia, illus. 1996
During a scarlet fever epidemic one winter in Michigan, a Jewish family helps make Christmas special for their sick neighbors by making their own Hanukkah miracle.
- The Hanukkah Mice by Randall, Ronne. / Kneen, Maggie, ill. 2002
While searching for the Hanukkah lights, three mouse children and their mother discover new treasures each night.
- Dinosaur on Hanukkah by Rauchwerger, Diane Levin / Wolff, Jason, illus. 2005
A dinosaur comes to a young boy's house to join him in celebrating Hanukkah.
- Jackie's gift: A true story of Christmas, Hanukkah, and Jackie Robinson by Robinson, Sharon / Lewis, E. B., illus. 2010
When young Steve Satlow, who is Jewish, tells his new neighbor, Jackie Robinson, that his family does not have a Christmas tree, Jackie brings one to his neighbors, not knowing that they don't celebrate Christmas. Based on a true story.
- Melly's Menorah by Rosenberg, Amye / Rosenberg, Amye, illus. 2012
The family can't find their Chanukah menorah, but the youngest child has a solution -- use the menorah shaped cookie she made!
- The Little old man and his dreams by Ross, Lillian Hammer. / Healy, Deborah, illus. 1990
An old man, who is beset by difficulties as he journeys to attend his granddaughters' wedding, finds strength as he dreams of God.
- Inside-out grandma: a Hanukkah story by Rothenberg, Joan. / Rothenberg, Joan, illus. 1997
Rosie's grandmother wears her clothes inside out to remind herself to buy oil for latkes during Hanukkah.
- Sammy Spider's first Hanukkah by Rouss, Sylvia A. / Kahn, Katherine Janus, illus. 1993
Sammy Spider shares Hanukkah with the Shapiro family through a tangled web of bright colors and numbers.

- Sammy Spider's First Taste of Hanukkah: A Cookbook by Rouss, Sylvia A. / Kahn, Katherine, ill. 2015
A collection of Hanukkah recipes and crafts that children can make with their parents.
- The return of the Golem: a Chanukah story by Ruggill, Peter. / Ruggill, Peter, illus. 1979
During the time of Hanukkah, the Golem, a clay man made by the Rabbi, saves a small village synagogue from some evil creatures from outer space.
- The picture story of Hanukah by Scharfstein, Sol / Haas, Arie, illus. 1973
The Story of Hanukkah, told in cartoon form.
- Potatoes At Turtle Rock by Schnur, Susan / Schnur-Fishman, Anna / Steele-Morgan, Alexandra illus. 2016
Annie leads her family on a nighttime journey around their farm to celebrate the first night of Hanukkah. At each stop along the way Annie uses riddles (and potatoes) to mark old traditions and start new ones.
- Hanukkah! by Schotter, Roni. / Hafner, Marylin, illus. 1990
Five young children and their family celebrate Hanukkah.
- The Odd potato -- a Chanukah story by Sherman, Eileen Bluestone. / Kahn, Katherine, ill. 1984
Rachel turns an odd potato into a symbol of Hanukkah reaffirmation.
- Hanukah money by Sholem Aleichem, 1859-1916. / Shub, Elizabeth, trans. and adapt. / Shulevitz, Uri, illus. 1978
Two young brothers wonder how much money they will receive from their relatives for Hanukkah.
- The Animated Menorah: Travels on a Space Dreidel by Sidon, Ephraim / Oren, Rony, illus. 1986
A series of imaginary adventures, one per candle, colorfully illustrated by photographs of clay-animated figures.
- Meet The Latkes by Silberberg, Alan / Silberberg, Alan, illus. 2018
Lucy Latke's family is a family of potato pancakes. After lighting the menorah and gobbling the gelt, Grandpa Latke tells everyone the Hanukkah story, but it's up to the Latke family dog to set the record straight.
- It's A Miracle!: A Hanukkah Storybook by Spinner, Stephanie / McElmurry, Jill, illus. 2007
Every night of Hanukkah Grandma tells a story at bedtime to her grandson. He must decide which are true and which are not. Includes the Hanukkah legend, blessings, and glossary.
- A Hanukkah With Mazel by Stein, Joel Edward / Vavouri, Elisa, illus. 2016
Misha has no one to celebrate Hanukkah with until he discovers a hungry cat in his barn. The lucky little cat inspires Misha to turn each night of Hanukkah into something special.

Illustrated short rhymes for each letter of the alphabet introduce customs of Hanukkah.

Sam is reluctant to make a menorah in Sunday School because his family already owns seven, but after a conversation with his grandmother, he figures out how to make a perfect Hanukkah gift.

A family argument on the first night of Hanukkah results in a food fight and a flying latke.

Jason's Miracle: A Hanukkah Story by Benderly, Beryl Lieff 2000

Twelve-year-old Jason has ambivalent feelings about Hanukkah until he finds himself transported back to the time of the Maccabean revolt in Judea.

Like A Maccabee by Bietz, Barbara / White, Anita, illus. 2012

Days before Chanukah, ten-year-old Ben prepares for the championship soccer game while pursued by the school bully and adjusting to a new roommate -- his grandfather.

Alexandra's scroll: the story of the first Hanukkah by Chaikin, Miriam. / Fieser, Stephen, ill. 2001

Alexandra, a young Jewish girl from Jerusalem, describes her life and the creation of Hanukkah, more than 2000 years ago.

Light another candle: the story and meaning of Hanukkah by Chaikin, Miriam. / Demi, illus. 1981

Retells the story of Hanukkah and explains its symbols by describing high points in Jewish history, worship, and culture. Bibliography: p. [78] Includes index.

The Christmas Revolution by Cohen, Barbara, 1932-1992. / DeGroat, Diane, illus. 1987

Two fourth grade Jewish children refuse to participate in the school Christmas celebrations.

An Adventure in Latkaland: a Hanukkah story by Fisman, Karen / McAteer, Thomas, illus. 2009

A magic dreidl transports Sarah and Jacob to a series of adventures in Latkeland.

Maccabee meals: food and fun for Hanukkah by Groner, Judyth Saypol. / Roma, Ursula, ill. 2012

Eight kinds of latkes and eight themed parties highlight this child-friendly Chanukah cookbook. Includes crafts, games, candle lighting blessings, and index.

The Spotted pony -- a collection of Hanukkah stories by Kimmel, Eric A, 1946- / Fisher, Leonard Everett, illus. 1992

Eight Jewish tales include legends and folklore introduced by a brief "shammes" story.

The Golden dreidl by Kushner, Ellen. / Winn-Lederer, Ilene, illus. 2007

After receiving a magic dreidel at a Hanukkah party, a girl is catapulted into a world of demons, fools, sorcerers, and sages.

The Hanukkah of great-uncle Otto by Levoy, Myron. / Ruff, Donna, ill. 1984

Joshua and his great-uncle Otto try to build a menorah like the special one Otto lost during the Holocaust.

Penina Levine is a potato pancake by O'Connell, Rebecca, 1968- / Lue Sue, Majella, illus. 2008

Sixth grader Penina is not looking forward to Hanukkah with her little sister who is always stealing the spotlight.

The Hanukkah Ghosts by Penn, Malka by 1995

On a visit to England, Susan finds herself mysteriously transported back to World War II, where she meets a Jewish refugee and a prejudiced young boy who help her understand and appreciate her Jewish heritage.

The very best Hanukkah gift by Rocklin, Joanne. / O'Neill, Catharine, illus. 1999

During Hanukkah, an eight-year-old boy learns the pleasure of giving and overcomes his fear of dogs.

My Lucky Dreidel: Hanukkah stories, songs, poems, crafts, recipes, and fun for kids by Schwartz, Cherie Karo. / Edelson, Wendy, illus./Gross, Jonathan, photo. 1994

Chanukah stories, songs, poems, crafts, recipes, and fun for kids arranged according to the themes of the holiday.

Describes the origin and significance of Hanukkah. Includes a holiday game, song, and instructions for the traditional candle-lighting ceremony.
